Dentsu Japan Network establishes Dentsu Corporate One Inc., a new company specializing in corporate functions —Corporate functions going hand-in-hand with business functions will contribute to the reform and growth of the Japan Business—

Dentsu Japan Network (hereinafter referred to as "DJN"^{*1}), which oversees and manages the Dentsu Group's business in Japan, has been promoting the structural reform of that business with the aim of evolving into an "Integrated Growth Partner."^{*2} With its "change in business formation"^{*3} strategy as one of the structural reform pillars, it has been accelerating the transformation of the Japanese business into four business domains (AX, BX, CX and DX) and the optimization of the organization. With regard to the corporate functions that go hand-in-hand with business functions to support business promotion, DJN will promote the consolidation of human resources and functions into the new company Dentsu Corporate One Inc. and aim for the sustainable growth of the business in Japan through the centralized and stable provision of these functions to DJN companies.

In the press release "Dentsu Japan Network to Establish a New Company that Realizes the Sophistication and Efficiency of Corporate Functions in the Dentsu Group's Business in Japan" that was issued on May 25, 2021, DJN announced the establishment of a new company and its purpose. The company's outline and management execution structure have now been decided as follows.

The new company Dentsu Corporate One Inc., which will start business in January 2022, was formed through the consolidation and integration of the human resources of Dentsu Management Services Inc. and Dentsu Works Inc., both of which are still mainly responsible for the specialized functions of DJN's general affairs, accounting, and personnel fields, together with the human resources of each of the organizations responsible for the major corporate functions at Dentsu Group Inc. a pure holding company, at Dentsu Japan Network, which oversees and manages the Dentsu Group's business in Japan and is an in-house company within the pure holding company Dentsu Group Inc, and at Dentsu Inc., a major operating company within Dentsu Group's business in Japan .

In close cooperation with Dentsu Group Inc., the new company will promote the standardization and visualization of the corporate operations required by DJN companies, and will drive the efficiency and appropriate cost-effectiveness of a wide range of operations, including support operations for business activities. From January 2022 onward, it will continue to expand the number of DJN companies to which the company provides services, and, after considering the appropriate target companies, timing and methods, promote the consolidation of the corporate functions of other DJN companies and promote the building of a strong management foundation for DJN as a platform for corporate functions.

In addition, the new company will continue to evolve its functions and the expertise of each corporate field in order to fully respond to the transformation and evolution of the business activities promoted by each DJN company. To give an example, it is expected that the new company will handle post-merger integration (PMI) of companies newly joining DJN through reorganization within DJN and M&As.
